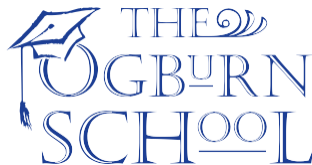

Graduation Requirements

To earn a high school diploma from The Ogburn School, Inc., students must complete the following courses:

- 4 English credits (English 1, English 2, English 3, English 4)
- 4 Math credits (Algebra 1, Geometry, and two from: Math for College Readiness, Algebra II, Special Topics, or Trig)
- 4 Science credits (Earth Science, Biology, Environmental Science required, + one elective science)
- 3 Social Studies credits (World History, American History, American Government, Economics)
- 9 Electives (Required electives include: Life Management, Outdoor Education, Career Research, Personal Financial Literacy, and Workplace Essentials)

Honors Courses Available: Prerequisites apply

A 2.0 GPA is required to earn a high school diploma from The Ogburn School. Students seeking state scholarships may need to meet additional requirements.

Students must submit scores from the MAP Online each academic year of enrollment before a student is promoted or transcripts are issued.

Juniors and/or Seniors may submit either MAP Online or college entrance exam scores to The Ogburn School before students are promoted or final transcripts are issued. Examples of acceptable exams are the ACT, SAT, CPT or PERT.
